### 4. FIRST-AID MEASURES:

### 5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES:

### 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES:

**Personal precautions:**

**Handling:**

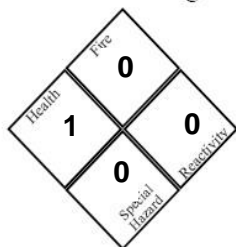
